### Lemon Blueberry Dump Cake

- 1 box vanilla cake mix
- 2 21-oz cans blueberry pie filling
- ½ cup butter melted (8 tbsp)

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Spray inside of 9x13 casserole dish with nonstick cooking spray. Empty cans of blueberry pie filling into bottom of dish, spread out evenly. In medium mixing bowl, combine dry cake mix and melted butter, and stir until a crumbly consistency. (Break up large chunks into small crumbles with a spoon). Pour cake crumble mixture over the blueberries in dish and spread evenly. Bake for 30 minutes, or until edges are hot and bubbly. Serve with ice cream or whip cream, enjoy!
