Above all,.....Love

Shirley Temple Party Punch

- Ice cubes
- Maraschino cherries (stems removed)
- 12 oz bottle Grenadine
- 6 cups orange juice (no pulp), chilled
- 2 liter bottle lemon lime soda (sprite)
- 2 liter bottle ginger ale chilled

Drop 1 maraschino cherry into each slot of 2 ice cube trays, then fill with water and freeze. Add the ice to a punch bowl. Pour grenadine over ice. Pour orange juice, lemon lime soda, and ginger ale on top. Give it a gentle stir to combine. Garnish with just a few orange slices and maraschino cherries. Ladle into cups or glasses and enjoy!
